Dear Museum Director or Private Collector,

The fossilized skull and tusks to the world's largest mastodon are currently for sale through the Lost World Museum. The "Lone Star Mastodon" was uncovered in Texas in 2000 and has been restored by Joe Taylor of the Mt. Blanco Museum. It is 20% larger than the Warren Mastodon of the Museum of Natural History, NY and 14% larger than the Burning Tree Mastodon from Newark, Ohio.

The selling price is \$250,000. It includes the complete skull, lower jaws, restoration tusks, real partial tusks, display stand on casters and the photographic and scientific history of the specimen (stills, videos and documentation). Additional features include magnetized restored tips of the lower tusks, an LED light illuminating the brain cavity, and a mini DVD player that plays a video about the mastodon for your patrons to enjoy.
